If you make it easy for someone to steal from your vehicle, chances are they will. So minimize the opportunity by practicing the following safety tips.

- ✓ Always lock your vehicle and take your keys.
- ✓ Never leave a spare set of keys in the vehicle such as in a magnetic box, above the visor or under the hood. Thieves ALWAYS check these areas.
- ✓ Always park in a well lighted area.
- √ When parking your vehicle, always make sure the windows are tightly closed.
- ✓ Keep all valuables out of sight, i.e.: iPods, GPS units, briefcases, computer bags, spare change and clothing.
- ✓ Anything of value left in your car attracts thieves.
- ✓ Dial 9-1-1 to report suspicious persons.
