I am writing to inform you about work that will be occurring in your ward. Our contractor will be installing a cement lining in the catch basins, manholes, and other drainage structures in your ward. If the structure requires repair before the lining can take place that work will be performed. Also, if the existing structure is completely collapsed; a new precast catch basin will be installed.


The limits of the work within the 47<sup>th</sup> Ward are as follows:


- North Limit – W. Lawrence Avenue
- South Limit – W. Montrose Avenue
- West Limit – N. Clark Street
- East Limit - N. Dover Street

This work represents a part of a larger project which includes parts of the 46<sup>th</sup> and 48<sup>th</sup> Wards. Work will begin the week of July 7<sup>th</sup> and it will take approximately four months to complete the entire project. You may notice manhole and catch basin cleaning trucks in your ward in advance of the structure lining process. In the last three years, the Structure Rehabilitation Program has been lining existing structures on the arterial streets throughout the city. The lining of the structures will extend the life of the structure by 30-50 years. The process of lining a structure is much cheaper than replacing the structure.
